



FULLY ADHERED ROOF SYSTEMS


Fully adhered systems using panels measuring up to 30 feet by 100 feet. The membrane is bonded to the insulation, which has been physically attached utilizing mechanical fasteners, stress plates and/or adhesives. Either non-reinforced or scrim reinforced membrane can be used, with the non-reinforced membrane making up most adhered installations. Fully adhered systems are lightweight and ideal for a wide range of building sizes and geometric configurations, including high-slope applications. Because of recent technological advances in application, the fully adhered system is becoming the system of choice for roof replacement applications in many areas of the country.





MECHANICALLY ATTACHED SYSTEM

Mechanically attached systems can be installed using large panels and attached through the membrane, or using narrow panels attached in the side laps. Non-reinforced or scrim reinforced membranes can be used, depending on the needs of the building owner. The membrane is then attached using either round plates or batten strips to the underlying deck. Mechanically attached systems are lightweight and are ideal for all building sizes and configurations.





BALLASTED ROOF SYSTEMS

Ballasted systems, the workhorse of the three EPDM roofing systems, account for approximately 35 percent of EPDM installations today. Using large panels measuring up to 50 feet by 200 feet, the ballasted system provides fast coverage at a relatively low cost. The EPDM panels are loose-laid over the insulation and held in place by smooth, river-washed stone or concrete pavers. Ballasted systems are primarily used for large new construction projects, but can also be used on roof replacement or recovery projects where the existing structure can support the additional weight. Ballasted systems are traditionally the easiest of all systems to install and have earned the Underwriters Laboratories Class A rating.





TPO (THERMOPLASTIC POLYOLEFIN)

Thermoplastic polyolefin (TPO) single-ply roofing membranes are among the fastest growing commercial roofing products and have gained broad industry acceptance for their many performance and installation advantages. As demand increases for heat-reflective and energy efficient roofing systems, TPO single-ply roofing membranes continue to provide exceptional resistance to ultraviolet, ozone and chemical exposure.

EPDM (ETHYLENE PROPYLENE DIENE TERPOLYMER)

EPDM is an extremely durable synthetic rubber roofing membrane (ethylene propylene diene terpolymer) widely used in low-slope buildings in the United States and worldwide. Its two primary ingredients, ethylene and propylene, are derived from oil and natural gas. EPDM is available in both black and white, and is sold featuring a broad variety of widths, ranging from 7.5 feet to fifty feet, and in two thicknesses, 45 and 60 mils. EPDM can be installed either fully adhered, mechanically attached or ballasted, with the seams of the roofing system sealed with liquid adhesives or specially formulated tape.

MODIFIED BITUMEN

Modified bitumen roof systems can be installed with the common torch method, asphalts, or cold adhesives. A standard SBS modified bitumen roof system is a two-ply system applied in rolls that overlap the edge of the previous roll. Modifiers are added to standard roofing asphalt to replace plasticizers removed during the distillation process. Bitumen is reinforced with fiberglass or polyester fiber matting in order to increase durability and strength.


TAPERED ROOFING SYSTEMS

Poor drainage on commercial roofs can result in damage far more destructive than either wind or other natural elements. Building owners often underestimate the advantages of tapered roofing when evaluating the life expectancy of a roof.

Positive drainage is necessary to ensure a safe, long lasting roof. Ponded water and freeze-thaw cycles can result in costly repairs and even pre-mature roof failure, which is rarely covered under warranty or by insurance. Positive sloped roof systems result in reduced maintenance and less stress to the building structure.

According to the Uniform Building Code, roof systems must be sloped a minimum of ¼ of an inch per foot for drainage. All three major code bodies accept this standard. However, some local codes accept retrofit roofs with a slope of only 1/8 of an inch per foot.

Tapered roofing is equally suited for new and replacement construction. In new construction, this can be achieved by designing a slope into the structure of the building. In this case, the roofing support columns are varied in height so the final roof deck has high and low points from which to place the roof drains. The easiest way to improve the slope of an existing roofing system is with the addition of insulation underneath the membrane. The thickness of the insulation is varied to create the necessary slope.

Metal Flashings — Including "Custom-Fit" Metal

Joints can leak, the metal itself can rust, or they can be improperly installed, causing leaks.

Flexible Wall Flashings

Can delaminate from the wall or slide off the wall (due to gravity), resulting in leaks and finger-pointing between the manufacturer and contractor.

Roof Penetrations (pitch pans, vents, drains, expansion joints, etc.)

Pitch pockets leak due to lack of maintenance; other roof penetrations can be improperly flashed, causing leaks.

Blisters In Membrane

Blisters form due to moisture vapor within the roofing assembly and can open (or be punctured by rooftop traffic), causing leaks.

Roof Insulation (under membrane)

Can cup, curl, shrink, or delaminate, resulting in membrane attachment problems and ultimately leaks (or even premature failure of the entire roofing system).
